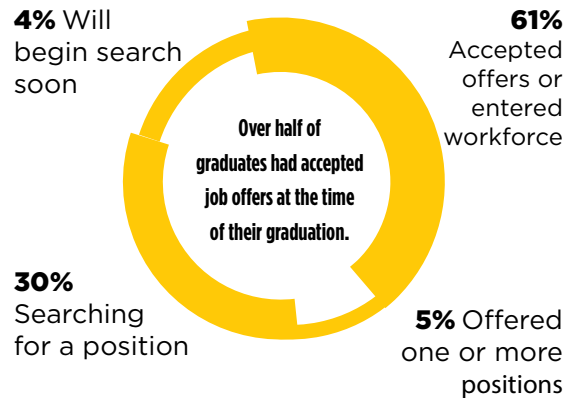
Summer 2019 - Fall 2019\*

To gauge the success of our programs, UCF administers the First Destination Survey to all graduating students. For the Summer 2019 through Fall 2019 **Engineering and Computer Science** classes, **94 percent** of **267\*\*** graduates completed the survey, and here's what they said.

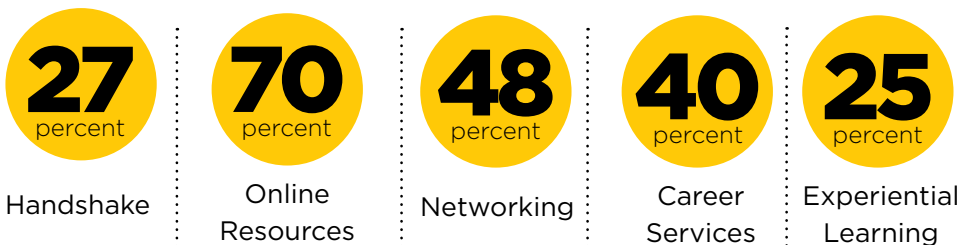
