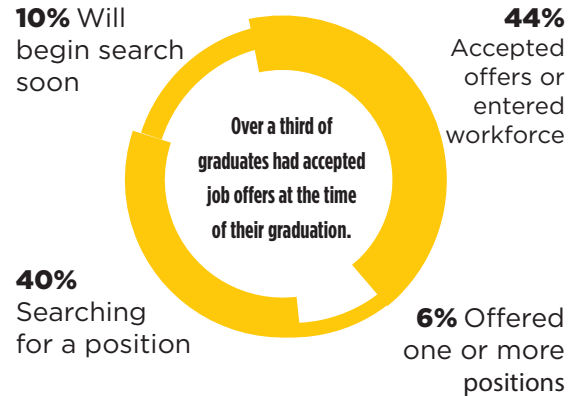
Summer 2020 - Spring 2021

To gauge the success of our programs, UCF administers the First Destination Survey to all graduating students. For the Summer 2020 through Spring 2021 **Engineering and Computer Science** classes, **88 percent** of **1,927** graduates completed the survey, and here's what they said.

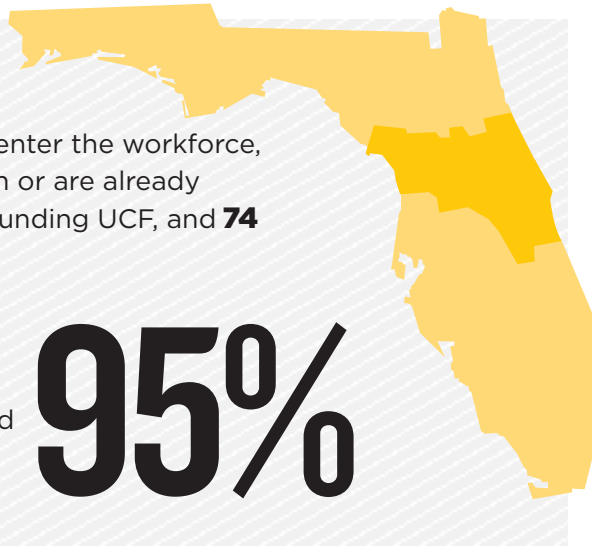
LOCAL IMPACT

For graduates who planned to enter the workforce, **61 percent** accepted a position or are already working in the 11 counties surrounding UCF, and **74 percent** will stay in Florida.

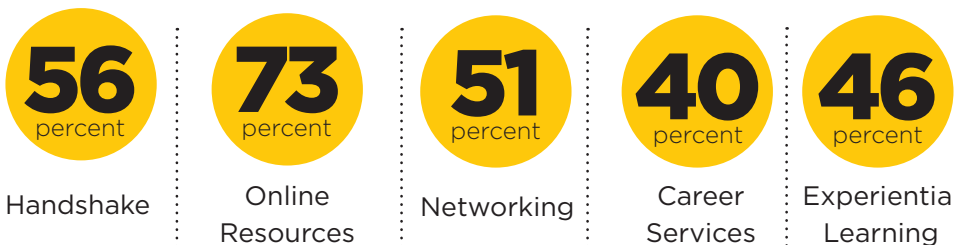
