CECS Graduate Student Self-Guided Tour



- 1 Millican Hall** This building is home to the College of Graduate Studies, the Registrar's Office (for transcript requests), and Student Accounts (which is where you can pay your tuition).



- 2 John C. Hitt Library** The library is a wonderful source of research materials for graduate students. It also permits students to rent laptops, equipment and reserve study rooms.



- 3 Colbourn Hall** Colbourn Hall is home to the Graduate Student Center and the university's Writing Center. The Grad Student Center features a computer lab with free printing (bring your own paper) and presentation and study rooms.



- 4 John T. Washington Center** This area of campus is where you will find the UCF Card Center (which is where you can get your student ID) and the campus bookstore.



- 5 Student Union** This building is the central hub of campus, with many eateries, spaces to study, a computer lab with free printing, a convenience store, and the SGA Ticket Center, which offers student discount tickets.



- 6 Health Center** The UCF Health Center offers a range of medical care including clinics, a pharmacy, a dental center, a women's care clinic, lab testing, and vaccinations.



- 7 Rec & Wellness Center** The Recreation and Wellness Center features 2 swimming pools, cardio and fitness floors, a 41-foot rock climbing wall, sand volleyball and multipurpose courts, aquatic fitness and more.



- 8 UCF International Hub** This where UCF Global is located. Any questions about maintaining your F1 or J1 visa should be directed to this office.
